Note: on Skill Hub Initiative

The 'Skill Hub Initiative' under the PMKVY 3.0 scheme focuses on the introduction of skill training programmes in the education ecosystems. The initiative would consider the policy level synergy on integration of vocational education with general education as envisioned in the NEP 2020.

Skill Hub across education and skill eco system has been proposed to actualize the intent of NEP on ground. The implementation of initiative shall ensure broad based convergence of vocational education and formal education in a phased manner.

Skill Hubs are nodal skill centres identified to provide skill development and vocational training opportunities to target population segments from 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> (introduction to world-of work through orientation, industry visits, bag less days), Class 9th to 12th (aimed at exposing students to skill development avenues), school dropouts, and out-of-education (aimed for academic credit, mainstreaming back to education, and or apprenticeship and employment linkage).

This can be accomplished through technical support, greater cross utilization of available infrastructure from Universities/ Colleges/ Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)/ Polytechnics/ Schools, and further strengthening of District Skill Committees (DSCs), State Skill Development Missions (SSDMs)/ State Directorate of Technical Education.

### Basics in the Pilot Phase

Around 5,000 Skill Hubs identified from across the education & skill ecosystems including Schools, PMKKs ITIs, Engineering Colleges, General Education Colleges, Polytechnics, Rural Self-Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs), JSS centres, NIELIT centres & MSME Skilling Institutions

A. **Vocational Course selection & mapping:** Courses under Samagra Shiksha/ any NSQF aligned course in pilot phase. Later to include courses basis local need in consultation with DSC

B. **Implementation Agency:** National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC)

#### • Target Segment:

- In-school students (Class 9-12th student cohort)
- School dropouts (class 6-12th student cohort)
- Out-of-Education candidates.
- Candidate between the age group of 15-45 years of age.

(In the pilot phase of the scheme only dropped out and out of school candidate are being targeted for training. )
