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1. ABOUT US: Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya is the second oldest College of Tripura. The College also had celebrated Golden Jubilee in the year 1999. It was established on 1st September 1950 with a view to spread man-making education particularly among the people of the-then North Tripura District and people of Tripura as a whole. Presently, the college of Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya is a Government institute, categorized as General Degree College and is functioning under the supervision of Department of Higher Education, Government of Tripura. The College is affiliated to Tripura University. The College has gone through different phases of undertaking, first primarily being private, semi Private and then fully governed by Government of Tripura. Since the inception from 1950, the College has grown in terms of number of student's strength, faculty, working staffs and increasing numbers of Departments offering Arts, Science and Commerce streams and also offering course in IT. At Present, there are 19 Departments, out of which around 17 Departments offer both Honours and General course. The College also offers Distance course under Tripura University and IGNOU Course. The Master Degree programme in the Subjects of Bengali and English under Tripura University will be introduced along with Six Degree colleges of Tripura with the notice publication by Director of Higher Education, Govt. of Tripura at the end season of 2021.

Brief History of the College: The College was run privately for more than thirty years. Thereafter, in the year of 1982 Government undertook the College. Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya is affiliated under UGC 2(F), 12B on and from the 4th March, 1989. The College was under the Calcutta University up to 1987 and from that very year Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya continues its journey under Tripura University. The endeavour of so many devoted persons has become fruitful ultimately.

[iii] For the aspirant students, this college is striving to develop as a University of the Northern region of Tripura. This Mahavidyalaya will be turned into a premiere institution by unfolding facilities of all modern educational needs

2. Current Status Course provision in the College:

Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya is affiliated under UGC 2(F), 12B on and from the 4th March, 1989, and now it is affiliated to Tripura University and is functioning under the Department of Higher Education, Government of Tripura. The strength of students has grown over 3000 with at least 30- 40 teaching faculty and working staffs and these numbers of faculty staffs fluctuates due to transferrable nature of job. The institution now has flourished with branches and diversion of offering both Major and General Courses under B.A, BSC, Bcom and IT streams of study. The institution offer the Courses in the subjects of Bengali ,English, Sanskrit, Kokborok, Political science, Economics, History, Philosophy, Education, Geography, Physical Education, Foundation Course under Information Technology(IT), Bachelor of Commerce (With Accountancy Major) and under B.Sc Course Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology and Human Physiology.

There are altogether 19 Departments in the College, and which out of 17 Departments are in the full-fledged state offering both Honours and General course. The remaining two Departments i.e. Physical Education and Kokborok offers only General courses and yet to be full-fledged Departments. However, many attempts are being made to upgrade into full-fledged Department that will offer both Honours and General Course. It is to mention that along with all the basic subjects, the courses of Distance Education Centre under Tripura University and IGNOU Study Centre are performing successfully in the College campus. The aspects of special importance are given on Extra Curricular Activities, Sports and Culture, NCC and NSS for all round development of personality and skill of the students. Recently, the Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya is being chosen to offer Master Degree Course in the subject Bengali and English under Master Degree along with other Six Government General Degree Colleges of Tripura as granted permission by DHE, Govt of Tripura. The effort is still in the process.

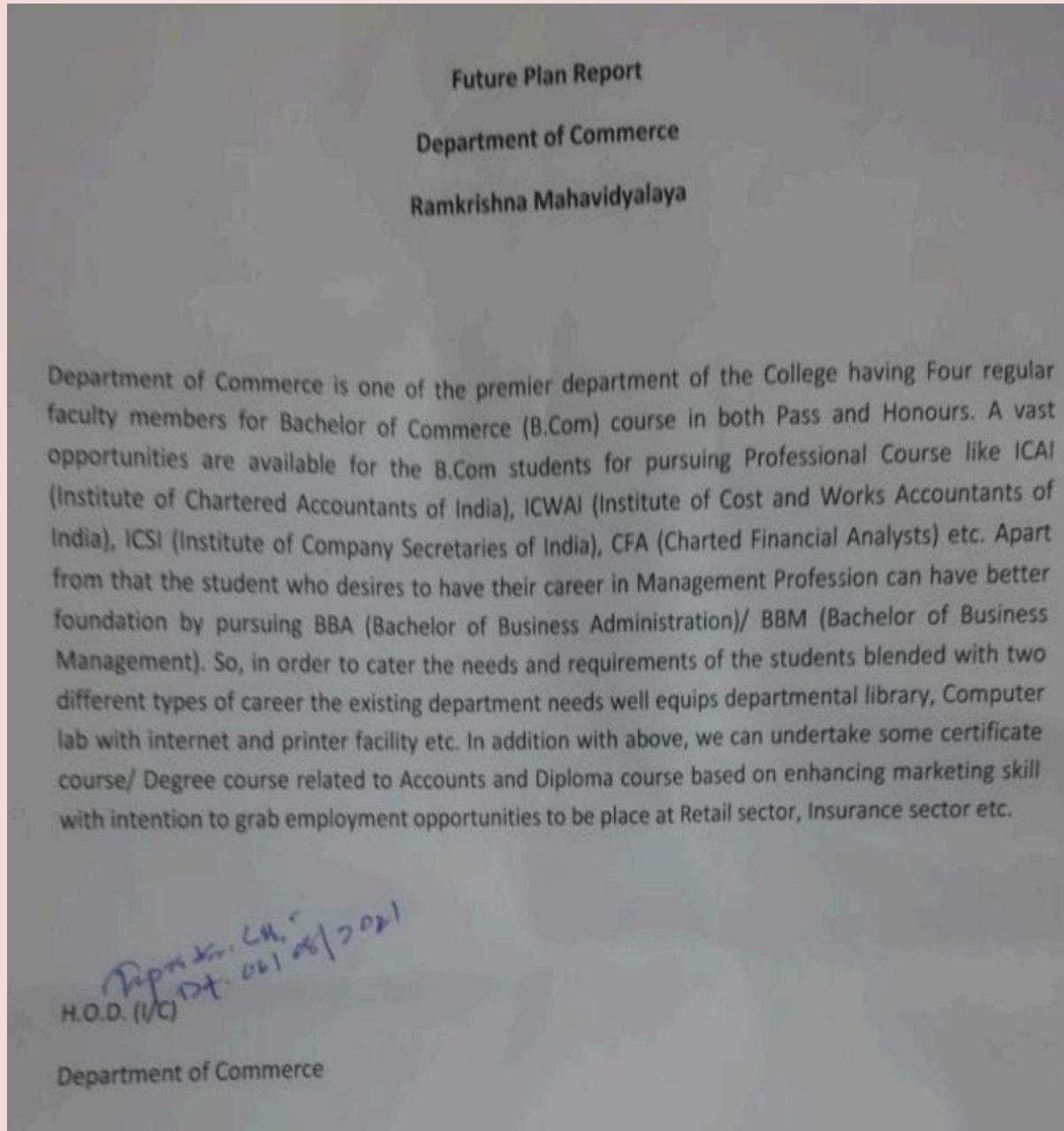

Introduction: The Department of Geography, R.K. Mahavidyalaya currently provides UG level 6 semester BA/BSC Geography Hons and Pass courses. The Department always strived to provide best quality of support for students learning. The long-term perspective plan of the department for next five year would mainly focus on the aspects of teaching-learning upgrade in addition to overall growth of the students for contributing and developing the skills and building Human resource.

The present Perspective Plan are prepared based on consultation and expertise of the following

- i. NAAC guidelines for ensuring quality aspects in the higher education
- ii. Vision and mission statement of the college
- iii. Internal Quality policy of the college
- iv. Inputs from stakeholders of the Departments and college
- v. Societal expectations from the Department

The perspective plan of the department mainly focuses on the following aspects

1. Infrastructural and Seat Capacity Extension of the Department.

- **To Extend and create Multiple Classrooms:** Presently, the Department of Geography has only two rooms which are being utilized compactly and scarcely. The Full fledged Department of Geography requires at least 4 to 5 rooms. Therefore, the Department has plans to extend to multiple rooms with separate theoretical smart class rooms and smart Practical Lab.
- **To extend the Seat Capacity:** The Department now only offers 10 limited seats in Honours Course. Once the Infrastructural rooms are extended, the Department will extend to 40 or 50 seats along with the conformity with other Colleges that offers Geography Honours course.

2. Teaching- Learning Equipments and tools

- **To Acquire more instruments and tools as required by the Department of Geography:** The practical lab materials and tools will be acquired. The Digital Dumpy level and many tools which are in limited number will be increased.
- **To establish GIS lab and Smart Practical Classroom:** The Department has plans to establish GIS(Geographical Information system) labs with at least 5 computers at hand for student's use with related Remote Sensing maps, toposheet maps, GPS, Projector and with the design of Smart board and Smart class room.

3. Teaching, Research & Innovation

- To motivate the faculty to remain exposed to the Industrial processes & activities.
- To conduct more conferences and workshops and Webinars in the Department.
- Initiate for collaborative research work among faculties and institutes.
- Engaging students in the Fruitful Field Projects and studying Environmental aspects of the District Unakoti.
 - To carry out National Project as sponsored by DST on various Environmental Issues of Unakoti District.
 - To upgrade the teaching and learning process to a more digital learning as in with conformity with the highest standard of leanings.

4. The Department which serves the Localities and Aspirations of the Students

- **To establishing Soil Testing and Water Testing Lab:** The Department of Geography carries Soil testing with the help of small Soil testing Kit as required for the fulfillment of the syllabus. The Department has plans to establish Soil testing lab and water testing in a larger way which can help the local farmers for free consultants with the Department.
- **To establish Small Weather Stations in the Department and College Campus:** Presently as per the Practical assignments, the Department has some weather related instruments like Thermometer, Hygrometer and Barometer and weather charts. The more items like Rainguage, Wind vane can be added to create and record local weather of the College campus and Kailashahar city at large.
- **To establish little Astronomical centre:** The Subject Geography is very much associated with study of solar system, planets and heavenly bodies. The procurement of medium range telescope will create interest for the students of the colleges to observe and view planets bodies, moons and other solar and moon eclipses and fulfill their soothing sight aspirations of heavenly bodies.
- **To establish small Geographical laboratory Museum:** The lovers of subjects Geography and other Students can get glimpses of environmental models (Landscapes, Mountain, Hills Rivers etc) presented in clays or plastic models. There may be displays of sample of various types of Rocks and minerals.

6. SWOC Analysis:

Institutional Strength: The College is the premier institute of the region and has provided educational service for many years.

- The College being the second oldest College in the State, it has therefore served in terms of catering the needs of higher education in the region.
- The College celebrated Golden Jubilee, and therefore has produced numerous batches of Alumni, and among which many are engaged in various fields and have worked in various important and reputed Govt. offices and companies; and to state that those Alumni are cooperative in the affairs of the College.
- Many of the teaching and working staffs were the product and alumnus of the college itself, and thereby creating an influence of emotional attachment and bondings towards the healthy development of the College.
- The College is known to produce academic excellence of the students and which some are holders of ranks in the affiliated university and which some have qualified in various

competitive examinations and UGC based NET/SLET examinations.

- The College has accumulated infrastructural developments and growth of multiple branches of departments of Arts, Science, Commerce and IT over time.
- The College being selected for offering Master Degree course in the subject English and Bengali along with other six General degree colleges of Tripura is another ‘feather in the cap’ catering to the education aspirants of Unakoti district.
- The College has good numbers of students strength numbering over 2000 students and also students from flung of the State comes to pursue higher studies in the institute.
- The College has dedicated and efficient working and teaching staffs who are ready for service 24 X 7.
- There is a healthy relationship between Teachers and the students and the institute work for the overall interest of teaching staffs and the students.
- The College can boast of diversity of its students. The students of various ethnicity and religions forms the bonafide students of the institute; and thus portraying the center of mosaic cultures and ethnicity.
- The College being located in the heart of Kailashahar town becomes the centre of attraction, and which therefore becomes more secure from internal and external nuisances, robbery and thieves; as the Police station and administrative offices are in the proximity and will be available at the call.

Institutional Weakness: The College does have some weaknesses which are being described in the following points.

- The College couldn’t fully utilize the actual designated boundary and which certain portions are being occupied by other governmental buildings and other private affairs.
- The College is compact and has limited space for college beautifications purposes and student’s recreation activities.
- The Arts block lacks sufficient rooms for assigning 3 to 4 rooms for each Department. Therefore, the Departments have to functions on limited rooms and wise management of classrooms.
- The College till today has no separate modern Auditorium for hosting over 1000 students at

one platform for various academic and cultural functions. The existing College hall is outdated and could accommodate hardly 300 students.

- The fluctuation of strength of Teaching and working Staffs fluctuates due to transferable nature of job policy.

Institutional Opportunities: Besides weaknesses, the institute also has several opportunities which could be wisely and tactfully bring under utilization if the efforts are being made.

- There is a growing demand for students for pursuing master degree programmes as the institute being the premier institute of the region. The institute can endeavour for incorporating Master Degree programmes and various other Disciplines.
- The hardworking and efficient nature of the working and Teaching staffs can be brought under utilizations for taking up several projects and research and upgrading some of the departments for master Degree Programmes.
- Adjacent to the College, there is a huge and magnificent stadium functioning through Sports Development Council, Govt. of Tripura. This stadium is at the disposal for student's sports and games activities. The hosting for inter-college sports and games becomes easier task.
- In the Proximity to the College, there is a centre of Ramkrishna Misson. The College collaboratively with the help of Ramkrishna misson can come up with related to Religion studies and also acts as center for spiritual development.
- The beautiful pond in the premises of the college can be converted into swimming pool, which can cater the needs of locality and students in learning basic life skills of swimming.
- There are several buildings blooming up in the College premises; the ongoing Science building block, works of first floor of administrative building, the functioning of well furnished canteen along with up gradation of Gym room will solve some of the crisis issues of the college.
- The numerous alumni batches of the College since the time of inception and their engagement in various important functions of governments and other affairs can be emotionally bonded and attached by the college and thereby taking various means of help.

Institutional Challenges and Threats: The College has various challenges and threats for overcoming and smooth functioning of the College:

- Due to transferrable nature of Jobs, the fluctuation of teaching and working staffs varies from time to time. The college gains efficient teacher through transfer and also loss dedicated teachers and working staffs through this policy.
- The teaching faculty of some department varies over time. In some significant time, some of the Departments are run through part-time guest Lecturer. Moreover, the teacher –student ratio in some Department become comparatively larger and many at times, the dependency on guest Lecturer becomes phenomena.
- The reduction of funds for developments by Higher Education becomes major monetary problems in developing the overall infrastructural developments and procuring some basic essentials tools of the College.
- As the institute is under the Department of Higher Education, Government of Tripura, many of the implementation and policies takes lengthier process, as the institute independently cannot decides some important issues of the College.
- The actual College premises is large enough for spacious beautiful campus, however the occupants of some governmental buildings and private affairs in some sections has resulted in locating the newly constructed ongoing Science Block building in a little discontinuous premises, separated by other buildings occupants.
- The enough rooms for each Department in Arts block are not sufficient and which therefore the college has to manage some of the classrooms. However, the newly constructed ongoing Science Building will create an ample space for all Departments to have minimum of at least 3 to 4 rooms allocated separately.
- The present science block is quite old and dilapidated, and therefore immediate renovation and making an earthquake resistant becomes the prime objective of the College for overcoming the obstacle.
